Leather or Synthetic Shoes in Halacha

In Jewish law, only leather shoes are considered to be "shoes" for purposes of the <u>Nine Days</u>, mourning, <u>Yom Kippur</u>, <u>shiv'a</u>, or ritual impurity. Non-leather shoes may normally be worn during those periods.
