Jewish Festival Day: When To Say Yizkor

<u>Yizkor</u> is not required to be said at all, but it is the custom in most places. <u>Yizkor</u> is normally said on <u>Yom Kippur</u> (and the final day of <u>Passover</u>, the second day of <u>Shavuot</u> and on <u>Shmini Atzeret</u>), when many people attend the <u>synagogue</u> prayer services.

Yizkor may be said anytime you wish—even when it is not a Jewish *festival*--and does not require a *minyan*.
