JEWISH FESTIVAL: LIGHTS

Jewish Festivals: Redirecting Lighting Fixture

You may redirect a light fixture on <u>Jewish festivals</u>, but only by moving it with a stick or other object, not directly with your hand.

NOTE During Jewish festivals, you may not:

- Turn this light on or off, or
- Disconnect its plug or light bulb.

Jewish Festivals: Moving Lighting Fixture

You may directly move a lamp or other light fixture to where you need the light but you may not:

- Plug or unplug the plug from the wall.
- Turn the light on or off.

Jewish Festivals: Unplugging Turned-Off Light

You may unplug a turned-off light on <u>Jewish festivals</u> if:

- You need the space where the lamp is situated, or
- The cord is in the way and you want to remove it so someone doesn't trip.

NOTE You may not turn off the light on *Jewish festivals*.
