PASSOVER NIGHT(S): EATING MATZA

When Eating Matza Is Obligatory

The only time when <u>matza</u> must be eaten to fulfill the commandment of eating <u>matza</u> is on <u>seder</u> night(s).

There may be a <u>mitzva</u> to also eat <u>matza</u> on the other days of *Passover* (but there are conflicting opinions about that).

However, men must eat <u>matza</u> in order to fulfill the commandment of eating two meals a day on each of the festival days.
