POST-PASSOVER

WHEN YOU MAY BUY CHAMETZ FOOD AGAIN

Store Owned by Jew Who Owned Chametz

You may buy <u>chametz</u> food from a store owned by a Jew who owned <u>chametz</u> during <u>Passover</u> as long as two weeks or more have passed since <u>Passover</u> ended.

REASON It is assumed that the old *chametz* has already been sold by then.

NOTE If you are certain that *chametz* in the store was there at any time during *Passover*, you may not

buy it.

Store Owned by Someone Who Did Not Own Chametz

You may buy *chametz* from a store owned by non-Jews (or by Jews who did not own *chametz* during *Passover*) as soon as the holiday has ended.
