PRONUNCIATION

Elo-ah

Pronounce God's name (spelled aleph, lamed, vav, heh) as Elo-ah, not Elo-ha.

HaMagbi-ah

The person who lifts up the *Torah* after it is read is called *ha'magbi-ah*, not *ha'magbi-hah*.

Hodo

When returning the <u>Torah</u> to the ark in the <u>synagogue</u>, the word is *hodo* (His glory), not *ho-DOO* (praise Him).

Yissaschar/Yissachar

When reading the *Torah*, do not pronounce the name *Yissachar* as it is spelled (*Yissaschar*).

NOTE Some people do read it as spelled but only the first time it appears in the <u>Torah</u>—that it, when he was born.
