When To Say Psalm 27/L'David Adonai Ori V'Yish'i

Begin saying L'David <u>Adonai</u> ori v'yish'i (Psalm 27) on the first day (at night) of <u>Elul</u>, not the first day of <u>Rosh Chodesh Elul</u> (the 30th of <u>Av</u>). The last day to say this Psalm is 22nd of <u>Tishrei (Shmini Atzeret</u>). This Psalm is recited twice daily, in <u>shacharit</u> after <u>shir shel yom</u> and in ma'ariv after <u>alenu</u>, including on <u>Shabbat</u> and <u>Jewish festivals</u>.
