

# AFTER-BLESSINGS (BRACHA ACHRONA): INCORRECT

## Correct After-Blessing after Incorrect After-Blessing

**SITUATION** You ate or drank mez<sup>u</sup>no<sup>t</sup>, wine, grape juice, or any of the Five Special Fruits.  
You said the incorrect after-blessing.

**WHAT TO DO** You must still say the correct after-blessing after the incorrect one.

## Correct After-Blessing after Incorrect Fore-Blessing

**SITUATION** You said an incorrect or too-general fore-blessing over food (even *she'hakol*--which does, *b'di'avad*, cover all foods, including bread, wine, the Five Special Fruits, and mez<sup>u</sup>no<sup>t</sup>). Or you forgot to say the fore-blessing.

**WHAT TO DO** You must still say the more-specific, correct after-blessing, including birkat ha'mazon when appropriate.

**REASON** You must still say the correct after-blessing even though you said the incorrect fore-blessing.
