Tish'a B'Av: What To Do after 12 Noon

After <u>halachic midday</u> on <u>Tish'a B'Av</u>, you may do any activities except the five activities forbidden on <u>Tish'a B'Av</u> (washing, anointing, eating/drinking, marital intercourse, wearing leather shoes) or the <u>Nine Days</u>. But you may not greet anyone, or reply to someone else's greeting to you, including saying "hello," "good morning," "how are you," etc., until after dark.
