## **Kashrut: Dairy/Meat: Cutting Boards**

You cut a spicy/*charif* item of one gender on a cutting board (whether wood or plastic), and then cut the opposite-gender spicy/*charif* food on that same cutting board.

STATUS Generally, the board and the knife and whichever food was cut second becomes non-

kosher. Consult a rabbi for exceptions.

WHAT TO DO If you can sand off the surface to below the level of any knife cuts, the board might be

kosher. Consult a rabbi.
