

# Kashrut: Dairy/Meat: Cutting Boards

SITUATION	You cut a spicy/ <u>charif</u> item of one gender on a cutting board (whether wood or plastic), and then cut the opposite-gender spicy/ <u>charif</u> food on that same cutting board.
STATUS	Generally, the board and the knife and whichever food was cut second becomes non- <u>kosher</u> . Consult a <u>rabbi</u> for exceptions.
WHAT TO DO	If you can sand off the surface to below the level of any knife cuts, the board might be <u>kosher</u> . Consult a <u>rabbi</u> .
