Flying through Shabbat for Business

If you fly through <u>Shabbat</u> (permitted for business only), you must keep even <u>Shabbat</u> d'rabanan while flying over the area of the earth that is in <u>Shabbat</u>.

If you fly east (such as from Asia to the US, across the Pacific) after <u>Shabbat</u> is over, you will reenter <u>Shabbat</u> and may not do <u>melacha</u> on the airplane. Say the <u>Shabbat</u> prayers and <u>kiddush</u> at the appropriate local time where you are flying.
