Ketuba Process

The <u>ketuba</u> is written before the wedding but is not finished until just before the signing, when one or a few last words are filled in. The <u>ketuba</u> is signed by two <u>kosher</u> witnesses after <u>tanayim</u>.

NOTE The *ketuba* is read later, under the *chuppa*.
