## **Introduction to Shmini Atzeret/Simchat Torah**

## **Timing**

In <u>Eretz Yisrael</u>, <u>Shmini Atzeret</u> and <u>Simchat Torah</u> are observed on the same day. Outside of <u>Eretz Yisrael</u>, <u>Simchat Torah</u> is the second day of what becomes a two-day festival.

## **Prayers**

We begin mentioning rain in the second paragraph of the <u>musaf amida</u> of <u>Shmini Atzeret</u> and continue until the first day of <u>Passover</u>.

## **Universal Customs**

The universal custom is to complete the reading of the *Torah* and to begin reading it again on *Simchat Torah*. Dancing and singing with the *Torah* scrolls is also a universal custom.
