JEWISH FESTIVALS: KIDDUSH: WHEN TO SPEAK OR DRINK

When You May Speak after Kiddush

You may speak, even without having drunk anything yourself, once:

- The leader (mevareich) has said Jewish festival (or Shabbat) kiddush for other people, and
- At least 2 fl. oz. (59 ml) of the wine (or other appropriate beverage) over which *kiddush* was made has been drunk.

When You May Drink after Kiddush

You may drink your own beverage as long as:

- The leader (mevareich) has said Jewish festival (or Shabbat) kiddush for other people, and
- At least 2 fl. oz. (59 ml) of the wine (or other appropriate beverage) over which <u>kiddush</u> was made has been drunk.
