Attire for Amida

The minimum attire required for men and women to say the <u>anida</u> is to be dressed appropriately to meet an important and respectable person.

Praying in Bare Feet on Stone Floor

You may pray in bare feet on any type of floor, even a stone floor, except when saying the amida.

NOTE You may not say the *amida* in bare feet.

Praying in a Kittel on Rosh Hashana

For those who have the custom of wearing a <u>kittel</u> on <u>Rosh Hashana</u>, the <u>kittel</u> is only worn for <u>shacharit</u> and <u>musaf</u>.
