SHACHARIT: SHEMA: WHEN TO SAY SHEMA BLESSINGS

When To Say Shema Blessings

Neither men nor women may say the blessings that precede and follow the <u>shema</u> after the fourth <u>halachic</u> hour of the day. In extreme circumstances (if compelled or forced), men (but not women) may still say the <u>shema</u> blessings until <u>halachic</u> midday.

Shacharit: Shema: El Melech Ne'eman

SITUATION

You are not with a *minyan*. You begin saying the *shema* and you realize you had forgotten to say <u>El melech ne'eman</u> before beginning the *shema*.

WHAT TO DO

Finish the <u>shema</u>; do not go back to say <u>El melech ne'eman</u> (and your saying the <u>shema</u> is still valid).
