WHEN TO PRAY: SHACHARIT: WHAT TIME TO FINISH

When To Pray: Shacharit: What Time To Finish

You must say the <u>shema</u> no later than the end of the third halachic hour of the day in the morning. If you did not say it in time:

- 1. If it is before the fourth halachic hour of the day, say the entire <u>shacharit</u> service, as long as you will complete the <u>amida</u> before the end of the fourth halachic hour.
- 2. If it is after the fourth halachic hour of the day but before the end of the sixth halachic hour of the day, say *birchot* ha'shachar (and you may also say korbanot) and then skip all of *shacharit* up to the *amida*, which you should say as soon as possible.
